



**Bria 2.0 for Microsoft Outlook[®]
Quick Start Guide**

This guide describes how to install and place a phone call using Bria for Microsoft Outlook®.

Bria for Microsoft Outlook is a standalone client; it does not require Bria or Bria Professional.

Complete information about using Bria for Microsoft Outlook is available after you have installed the application by choosing Actions > Help on the Bria toolbar.

Getting Ready

Account Information

You will need the following information from your VoIP service provider:

- User name
- Password
- Authorization Name (if applicable)
- Domain
- Firewall traversal and other network information; see the Bria for Microsoft Outlook Administration Guide.

System Requirements

- PC / OS: Computer running Windows 2000, Windows XP, or Windows Vista
- SIP VoIP account: At least one account with any VoIP service provider that uses the SIP signaling protocol
- Audio devices: Computer speaker and microphone, for example, headset or external speaker and microphone
- Software:
 - Microsoft Outlook® 2003 SP2 (standalone or Exchange) or Outlook® 2007
 - Microsoft Windows® Installer 3.0
 - Microsoft .NET Framework 2.0
 - Microsoft Internet Explorer® 6 or higher.

Installing Bria for Microsoft Outlook

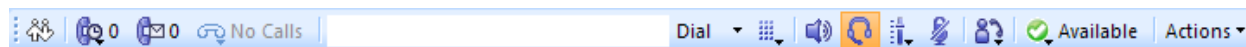
Installation requires Windows administrative privileges.

Install the application by double-clicking the MSI file and following the install wizard.

You will be prompted for the license key. This key was sent to the e-mail address that you provided when you purchased Bria for Microsoft Outlook from the store on the CounterPath website.

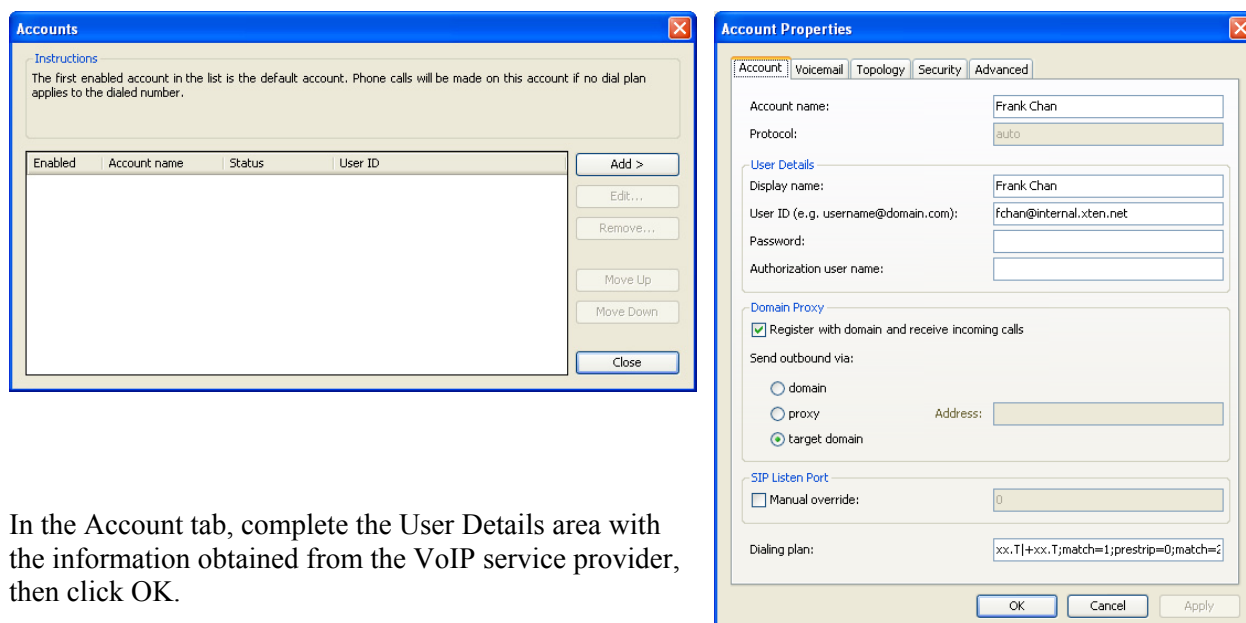
Configuring Bria for Microsoft Outlook

1. Start Outlook.



2. Activate the software (Actions > License).
3. Choose Actions > Accounts from the Bria toolbar. The Account Settings window appears.

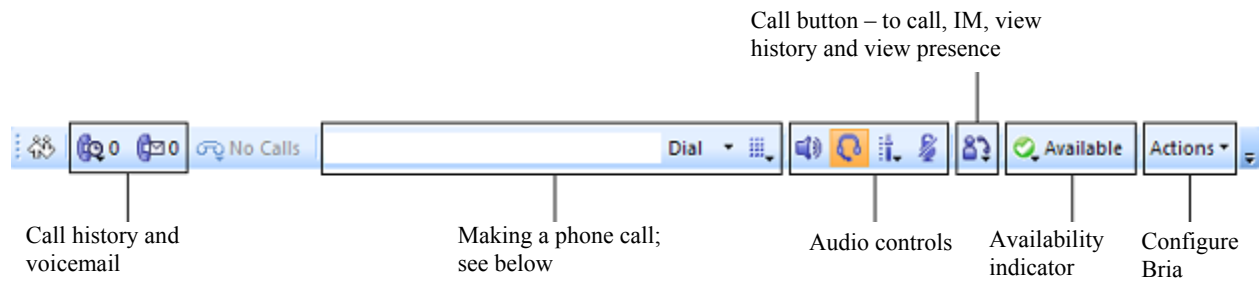
Click Add. The SIP Account window appears.



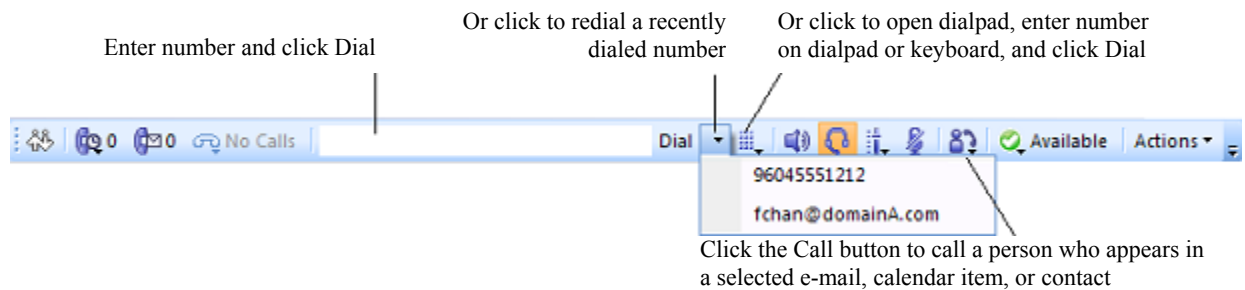
In the Account tab, complete the User Details area with the information obtained from the VoIP service provider, then click OK.

4. On the Account Settings window, enable the account and press Close.

Making a Phone Call



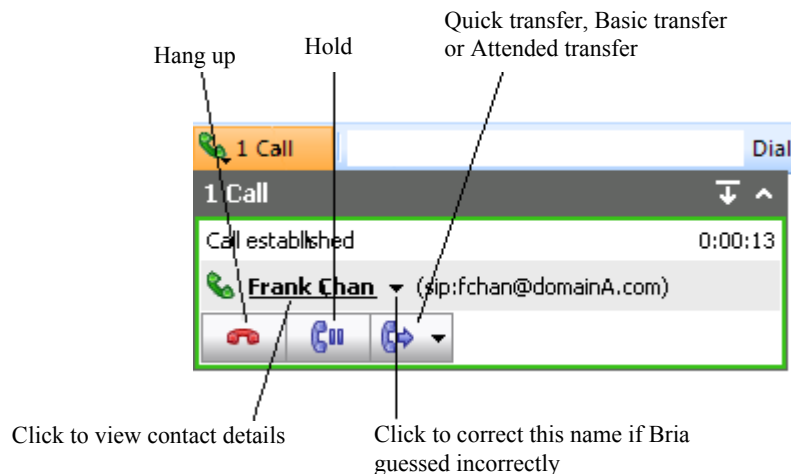
Troubleshooting

- If the call cannot be made, you may need to provide more account configuration information, specifically:
 - Account tab, Domain Proxy area.
 - Topology tab, if your computer is on a network and/or behind a firewall.

- If the account is configured properly, you may need to modify the dial plan. See the Administrator's Guide for details.
